

### Anesthesiology Locum Opportunities (Regina, SK)

We invite you to join our dedicated team anesthesiologists in the Department of Anesthesia in Regina. As a locum, you will be part of a close-knit group committed to delivering safe, high-quality, and efficient patient care. We value the relationship we have with our entire operating room teams, and we appreciate your efforts to maintain those relationships while working in our department.

#### Requirements

1. Fellow of the Royal College of Physicians of Canada (FRCPC).
2. Licence from the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Saskatchewan (CPSS)

#### Required Dates – April - December 2025

- Weekday coverage: Shifts 0745 – 1630 (elective OR lists)
- Weekday on-call coverage: 1600 - 0800
- Weekend call coverage: 24 hours (0800 – 0800)

#### Remuneration

1. **In Province Locums:** Fee for Service Billings (\$3,000/day guarantee).
2. **Out-of-Province Locums:** \$4,000/day flat rate.
3. **On Call:** Stipend paid through Specialist On-Call Remuneration Program (SECP) – this is approximately \$500 dollars per call done.
4. **Flights/travel:** Standard/basic fares OR mileage at \$0.57/km is provided  
Accommodation: Reimbursement of up to \$200 per night upon submission of SHA claim form

#### Clinical Responsibilities

We have two primary hospitals in Regina, and you will be placed in a practice that aligns with your experience and comfort level.

- **Regina General Hospital**, our trauma center, provides cardiac, obstetrical, and neonatal anesthesia, along with services for various surgical subspecialties.
- **Pasqua Hospital** is a community-based hospital where we offer anesthesia for general surgery, orthopedics, urology, plastic surgery, and ophthalmology.

The locum agreement includes the provision of anesthesia call at one of the hospitals, with a frequency of 1 in 5 call. Our call works as follows: You come in and do your elective day list and then stay in the evening (typically until 11 pm) to do emergency cases. You only get called back to the hospital after midnight for 'life or limb' cases. When you are on call, if you are not a cardiac/neonatal anesthesiologist, we will always have someone on call who can be called in to do those cases.
